Start/Finish:

Will be in the Halfway Forest, Nr Llandovery. Full details and directions will be published in the final instructions.

Entries and Fees:

Will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding, in writing at least 7 days prior to the event. **In such cases £20 will be deducted to cover costs.** Entries close on Friday 12th April or when full (Max 160 in order of receipt).

Individual Entry - £95.00

Eligibility:

All riders must hold a current ACU or SACU competition licence and be aged 16 years or over. WTRA membership is required in the absence of another ACU Affiliated Club membership. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance.

ACU Membership and ACU Competition licences:

You will need an annual Enduro Competition licence, or a one event competition licence, which includes ACU membership. Please contact ACU at Auto Cycle Union, ACU House, Wood Street, Rugby, CV21 2YX. Telephone 01788 566400 for annual licence. One event licence is available via the WTRA on-line entry form and NOT the ACU online system - see below.

Capacity Groups:

As per the 2024 ACU Enduro Regulations. Please check and ensure you enter the correct group.

E125 - Up to 125cc 2 Stroke and 4 Stroke
E1 - Up to 250cc 2 stroke and 4 stroke Enduro
E2 - From 255cc to 450cc 4 stroke
E3 - Over 255cc 2 stroke and over 455cc 4 stroke

Course:

Full details of the course will be announced with the final instructions. It is expected that the lap length will be approximately 15 miles with all refuelling at the start/finish area. There will be one special test. All class time allowances and any changes to the final instructions will be available at the start control.

Rules/Penalties:

As laid down in the 2024 ACU Handbook

Machine Examination/Sign On:

Will be between 8.00 am and 9.45 am on Sunday 28th April 2024 only. You will need to sign on **BEFORE** machine examination to collect your competition numbers. Signing on will finish at 9.45 am.

Noise:

Random noise tests may take place during the event and motorcycles deemed to be excessively noisy will be disqualified. Failure to stop for a noise test will result in immediate exclusion.

Tyres:

Front and Rear MUST be 'Enduro' type to current FIM specification. AC10's do not conform to FIM regs.

Results:

Will be available on the club website www.wtra.co.uk as soon as possible after the finish of the event.

SPECIAL NOTES

1. Machines must have proper numbers on the correct colour backgrounds as ACU Enduro Standing Regulations.
WTRA WILL SUPPLY RIDER NUMBERS AND BACKGROUNDS AT SIGNING-ON
2. Only Competitors are allowed to ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons found riding or driving in the forest or on any part of the course. Having a support rider means competitor will be disqualified.
3. Ensure that you do not block the free run of competitors into and through the refuelling points, checks and special test areas.
4. No smoking is allowed in the parc fermé, the start area or in any part of the forest.

Competitors can join/renew WTRA membership as part of the online entry system. You can then use this on the ACU SPORT:80 system to support your 2024 ACU Licence application.
