This event has been put together as an entry level introduction to timecard enduros for riders who have not entered this type of event before and to encourage the Youth class. Experienced riders are, of course, welcome to enter.

Start/Finish:

Will be in the Crychan Forest, Nr Llandoverly. Full details and directions will be published in the final instructions. The first riders will start at 10:00.

Entries and Fees:

Will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding, in writing at least 7 days prior to the event. In such cases £10 will be deducted to cover costs. Entries close on Friday 4th October or when full (Max 120 in order of receipt).

Individual Entry - £60.00

Eligibility:

All riders must hold a current ACU or SACU competition licence, and be aged 15 years or over. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance.

ACU Membership and ACU Competition licences:

You will need an annual Enduro Competition licence, or a one event competition licence, which includes ACU membership. Please contact ACU at Auto Cycle Union, ACU House, Wood Street, Rugby, CV21 2YX. Telephone 01788 566400. One event licences will be available. See on-line entry form.

CLASSES:

1. Expert 2. Clubman 3. Veteran Over 40 4. Veteran Over 50 5. Sportsman 6. Youth *

*A Youth rider may compete as an Adult in these events but must be a minimum of 15 years of age and is restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 250cc

CAPACITY GROUPS:

E1 - Up to 125cc 2 strokes and up to 250cc 4 strokes

E2 - 126cc to 250cc 2 strokes and 251cc to 450cc 4 strokes

E3 - 251cc to 500cc 2 strokes and 451cc to 650cc 4 strokes

Course:

Full details of the course will be announced with the final instructions. It is expected that the lap length will be approximately 12 miles with all refuelling at the start/finish area and one timecheck per lap. There will be one special test. All classes time allowances and any changes to the final instructions will be available at the start control.

Rules/Penalties:

As laid down in the 2019 ACU Handbook

Machine Examination/Sign On:

Will be between 8.00 am and 9.30 am on Sunday 13th October 2019 only. Machines must be presented for examination **BEFORE** signing on. Signing on will finish at 9.45 am.

Noise:

Random noise tests may take place during the event. Failure to stop for a noise test will result in immediate exclusion.

Tyres:

Front and Rear MUST be 'Enduro' type to current FIM specification. AC10's do not conform to FIM regs

SPECIAL NOTES

1. Machines must have proper numbers on the correct colour backgrounds per class of entry - see the ACU handbook 2018
2. Only Competitors are allowed to ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons found riding or driving in the forest or on any part of the course. Having a support rider means competitor exclusion.
3. Ensure that you do not block the free run of competitors into and through the refuelling point, checks and special test areas.
4. No smoking is allowed in the parc ferme, the start area or in any part of the forest.

Competitors can join WTRA as part of the on line entry system.

If you wish to use WTRA membership to apply for an ACU licence, the Entries Secretary who will provide a unique code that you can use to complete a licence application on the ACU website.
