With the kind permission of Natural Resources Wales, Llandoverly District, WTRA Ltd will hold an Open Timecard Enduro for solo machines to be held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the 2026 Timecard Enduro Standing Regulations of the ACU, the published supplementary regulations and any final instructions that may apply.

Start/Finish:

Will be in the Crychan Forest, Nr Llandoverly. Full details and directions will be published in the final instructions. The first riders will start at 10:00.

Entries and Fees:

Will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding, in writing at least 7 days prior to the event. In such cases £20 will be deducted to cover costs. Entries close on Friday 25th September 2026 or when full (Max 140 in order of receipt). **Late entries accepted after the closing date will be subject to a surcharge of £10**

ACU One Event Licence - £25

Entries open 7pm on Friday 14th August at www.wtra.co.uk and NOT the ACU on-line entry system.

Eligibility:

All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU or SACU competition licence and be aged 16 years or over except those entering the youth class. Youth* riders (ACU Short Course Timecard Enduro Regs 2026 - TCR 1 Eligibility) please note:

- 14 years of age - restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 125cc
- 15 years of age - restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 250cc
- Youths must carry their own timecards

NB A rider who chooses to compete as an Adult cannot also compete as a Youth at any time in the same event.

ACU Membership and ACU Competition licences:

You will need a current annual Youth Timecard Enduro Licence or, for adult riders, a current Adult Enduro Competition licence, or a one event competition licence, which includes ACU membership.

For annual Youth Timecard and Enduro Competition licence, please contact ACU at Auto Cycle Union, ACU House, Wood Street, Rugby, CV21 2YX. Telephone 01788 566400. ACU one event licences can be purchased on the entry form for £25.

Classes:

1. Championship 2. Expert 3. Clubman* 4. Ladies* 5. Veteran Over 40* 6. Veteran Over 50 Clubman* 7. Veteran Over 50 Sportsman 8. Sportsman 9. Youth (* - Clubman Schedule)

Youth riders are able to use M/X bikes and tyres providing their exhaust meets the noise limits as defined in ESR.11 of the 2026 ACU Handbook..

Capacity Groups:

E125 - 125cc 2 stroke and 4 stroke

E1 - Up to 250cc 2 stroke and 4 stroke

E2 - From 255cc to 450cc 4 stroke

E3 - Over 255cc 2 stroke and over 455cc 4 stroke

Course:

Full details of the course will be announced with the final instructions. It is expected that the lap length will be approximately 14 miles with all refuelling at the start/finish area. There will be one special test. All class time allowances and any changes to the final instructions will be available at the start control. There are no road sections in the route. An optional, alternative route may be available for sportsman and youth riders at particular points on the course.

Rules/Penalties:

As laid down in the 2026 ACU Handbook

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Sign On / Machine Examination:

Signing on will be between 8.00 am and 9.30 am on Sunday 4th October. Sign on and collect your rider numbers before machine examination. Machine examination will finish no later than 9.45 am.

Noise:

All machines should not exceed the maximum sound level limit as defined in ESR.11 of the Enduro Standing Regulations 2026. Any rider who fails the sound level test will face immediate disqualification and must hand in their timecard.

Tyres:

Unless entering as the "Youth" class, in which case MX tyres are permitted, Front and Rear tyres MUST be 'Enduro' type to current FIM specification.

Results:

Will be available on the club website www.wtra.co.uk and Facebook as soon as possible after the finish of the event.

SPECIAL NOTES

1. **WTRA WILL SUPPLY RIDER NUMBERS AND BACKGROUNDS AT SIGNING-ON.**
2. Only Competitors are allowed to ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons found riding or driving in the forest or on any part of the course. Having a support rider means competitor exclusion.
3. Ensure that you do not block the free run of competitors into and through the refuelling point, checks and special test areas.
4. No smoking is allowed in the start area or in any part of the forest.

Competitors can join/renew WTRA membership as part of the online entry system. You can then use this on the ACU SPORT:80 system to support your 2026 ACU Licence application.
