Start / finish: Will be in the Crychan Forest, Llandovery, map ref SN 868424, and will be signposted with yellow arrows off the A483 Llandovery to Builth Wells road at Cynghordy (Post code SA20 OLG). **The first Rider Starts at 10.01 am**

Signing-on / Machine Examination / Transponders: Signing-on will be between **08.00 and 9.30am** on Sunday 3rd March. Bikes **MUST** then pass through machine examination, where transponders for Special Test timing, will be fitted by the Organisers, before you will be allowed to start. Machine examination will finish at **09:45**. **You must ensure you have the correct number plate backgrounds as defined in the ACU Handbook ESR.11 Rider's Numbers.**

The transponders will be fitted by the organisers and it is the rider's responsibility to ensure the transponder is returned. A security deposit (£20) or ACU licence must be left with the Organisers when the transponder is assigned and will be refunded on the safe return of the transponder as you finish the event. One-event licences are not acceptable as a security deposit.

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Course & Special test: The course will be approx. 24 miles per lap of forestry going and will be marked with orange arrows. There will be one special test per lap (not timed on the first lap). **It will not be possible to walk the test prior to the event. Also, the test will not be accessible on the day of the event.** Special test timing will be by transponder. The number of laps is likely to be Sportsman and Veteran Over 50 2 laps, Clubman and Veteran Over 40 3 laps, Experts and Championship 4 laps (this may change depending on weather).

You should be prepared to meet other people in the forest (Horses, Cyclists etc), please report any problems to the travelling marshals or the next check.

Special note: To ensure Rider Safety, no unauthorised vehicles (support crew or spectators) are allowed in the forest outside of the Start Area. Failure to observe this rule will result in the exclusion of your rider.

Refuelling: Will be at the start finish area only. Failure to observe this rule will result in the rider being excluded. All petrol must be in approved containers. **No smoking in the refuelling area.**

Noise: Any bike fitted with any silencer that is considered to be excessively noisy, will be noise tested and will not be allowed to start the event until it is able to pass a noise test.

Tyres: Front and Rear tyres must be '**ENDURO**' type to current FIM specification. **Wrong tyres = no start!!!!!!** So please don't turn up with road legal MX tyres (e.g. AC10's) as they are not allowed.

Power Washers / Goggle Tear Offs: These are not permitted at the event

First Aid: Will be provided by the St John Ambulance Brigade who will have 2 ambulances on the course. The nearest casualty Hospital is at Carmarthen, Tel 01267 235151.

Finish: Please make sure that you hand in your time card and return your transponder when you finish or if you retire. The Travelling Marshals will not thank you if they spend time searching for you in the forest when you are warm and safe at the finish.

ACU Licences: At signing-on you will be asked to display your 2019 ACU licence. **Failure to provide a valid 2019 ACU licence will mean purchasing an ACU one event licence for which you will have to pay £15.00 cash.**

PLEASE place all litter in the bins provided or take it home with you. Leave the local people with their villages and countryside as it was when you arrived and their impressions of motorcyclists untarnished.

This event takes place with the permission of the Forestry Commission. **No motorcycling is allowed on any parts of the course, other than during the event.** Failure to observe this condition could jeopardise our use of the forest for future events.
